### Leadership e clinical leadership 1

#### Introduction

The aim of the module “Leadership and Clinical Leadership 1” is to provide skills about nursing leadership. It is usually considered the leadership in the management positions but it is not considered the importance of leadership of the nurses in different clinical roles, e.g. clinical nurses or advanced practice nurses. Changing and broadening the perspective with which nursing leadership is thought of and observed promotes the view of the leader as one who is not only a catalyst for change and improvement but also one who inspires colleagues in the professional and interprofessional team.

One aspect to consider is that the world of healthcare is complex and rapidly changing, giving nurses, in their different roles, the opportunity to exercise leadership and drive change. This module, by exploring topics such as adaptive leadership and transformational leadership, aims to prepare students to become transformational leaders ready to take on the multidimensional complexity of the role. In developing the entire module, opportunities to prepare students for the paradigm shift mentioned above were addressed by considering unexpected frames, including sharing part of the course (1 of 2 ECTS) in a classroom characterized by interprofessional and international diversities.

To make all of these possible, the strategy is to work together, fostering constant discussion and adopting user-friendly tools that improve digital literacy and a secure platform that complies with privacy regulations.
