

## Why choose this Bachelor's degree

It is a professional training that enables students to work with methodological, technical and scientific skills in the conservation of cultural heritage, aware of the value of the works they are working on. The workshops and teaching activities bring students to confront with a multifaced heritage, located in relevant local, national and international contexts.

## Professional perspectives

The qualification obtained allows to work in Switzerland and abroad as an employee in private companies or public institutions with a focus on wall paintings, stone and stucco decorations.

## Educational perspectives

It is possible to continue the studies at SUPSI with a Master of Arts in Conservation-Restoration or with other Master degrees at Swiss or foreign universities and polytechnics. It is possible to access continuing education programs such as the CAS-Certificate of Advanced Studies, the DAS-Diploma of Advanced Studies, and the MAS-Master of Advanced Studies.

## Admission requirements

Admission is possible with an MPA-Maturità professionale creazione e arte or with an MPT-Maturità professionale tecnica in a profession related to the field of study. Further information on the requirements can be found on the Bachelor program webpage.
