


What it is about

The interior architect shapes the interior environment and its quality by taking on its symbolic, functional, technical and aesthetic requirements. He/she is a professional figure who wisely combines the perceptive factors of space with specific skills in the fields of design, interior construction and communication.

How it is structured

The curriculum is organized in five operational areas: Design, Materials and Perception, Manual Intelligence and Constructive Techniques, Dwelling and Space Theories, Image Construction.



Why choose this Bachelor's degree

The Bachelor's degree responds to the new expectations of the market. It outlines the skills profile of its graduates into three strategic sectors: scenography (retail design, exhibit design, event design), spaces for tourism and leisure (hotels, restaurants, bars, public venues), work and training spaces (banks, companies, offices, schools). The Bachelor is designed like a creative Factory, encouraging continuous confrontation with lecturers and professionals, experimenting with ideas and spatial visions. Thanks to a flexible curriculum organized in five areas, each student in the Factory can enhance his or her interests and talents by building a customized study path.

Professional perspectives

The SUPSI interior architect works in specialised firms:

- in interior architecture and design
- in the design of museum and exhibition spaces
- in light and furniture design

Educational perspectives

After the Bachelor's degree, it is possible to continue studies by pursuing Master's programmes in related fields, offered by universities in Switzerland and abroad, as well as in education programmes such as CAS-Certificate of Advanced Studies, DAS-Diploma of Advanced Studies, MAS-Master of Advanced Studies.

Admission requirements
