The ICARO Project

The project and objectives

The ICARO Project, ICT and Advanced Nursing to Reconsider Learning Outcomes, responds to the priority of Digital Transformation, in the postgraduate education of the health professions (Master of Sciences), and it promotes new partnerships for the internationalization of the involved universities, realizing exchanges of knowledge, and experiences, with the ultimate goal of training nurses, with advanced practices competencies, capable of supporting what is proposed at the European level for the protection of public health.

Just like Icarus rising above a labyrinth of closed roads, this protection must be considered with a view from above that allows an overview and overcomes linguistic, social, and cultural barriers, to promote the undisputed right to health.

The project's objectives are:

- 1) To implement the use of ICT in all the universities involved, using user-friendly tools and secure platforms that respect privacy rules
- 2) To promote cooperation between universities and health companies
- 3) Promote digital literacy of students and lecturers
- 4) To propose a new educational offer through high-quality content, which enriches students' competencies in a logic of Advanced Practice Nursing, understood as a nurse with advanced knowledge and skills, applicable in clinical, coaching/training, management, and research
- 5) To promote employability through the creation of advanced skills, networking, and the implementation of the English language
- 6) To promote internationalization through virtual and real mobility, lecturers and working students who normally have more difficulties in long-term exchange
- 7) To promote the use of the English language for students and teachers
- 8) To promote a network of advanced practice nurses

Lessons and how to get there

Lessons will take place at:

Azienda ospedaliero-universitaria di Parma - Aule Moruzzi

- As soon as you pass through the entrance gate at Via Gramsci 14, turn immediately left, then right to enter Viale Istituti Universitari
- Walk along Viale Istituti Universitari until you see side street 4C on your left
- Take side street 4C, then turn immediately right onto Via Est
- You will then arrive at the Aule Giuseppe Moruzzi, where the course will be held – specifically in Aula 7 on the first floor

Where to park your car

From Autostrada A1 "Parma" to Parcheggio Goito

Google Maps: Parcheggio Goito - Via Goito, 1/A, 43121 Parma PR

- Exit the Autostrada A1 at "Parma" and follow the signs for the **Parma Centro**
- Continue straight on **Viale Europa** for approximately 3 km
- At the eighth roundabout, turn left onto **Viale Vittorio Bottego**
- Continue in the same direction, then proceed onto **Viale Mentana**
- At the first intersection, go straight ahead, then turn and take **Stradone Martiri della Libertà**, follow it to the end
- Turn right onto **Via Goito**
- The PARCHEGGIO GOITO is located at number 1/A

HOW TO PAY FOR THE WEEKLY PARKING PASS – PARCHEGGIO GOITO

- Before entering the parking lot, remove any Telepass and/or Unipolmove devices from the vehicle, if present. It is recommended to leave the device with a passenger who will not pass through the entry gate (in any case, do not use these devices for the entire week until departure)
- Enter the parking lot and take the ticket
- Go to one of the automatic payment machines and, after inserting the ticket, select the 7-day option from the display
- Pay the amount of € 65.00
- Keep the ticket, as it serves as your weekly pass (you can use it to exit and re-enter the parking lot during your stay)

How to reach your accomodation and the course location

From Parcheggio Goito to Foresteria in Borgo Felino n. 7 (by foot)

- Exit the Parcheggio Goito and proceed along Via Goito toward Borgo Salnitrara
- Continue straight for 70 meters and turn right onto Strada Luigi Carlo Farini
- Continue straight for 40 meters and turn left onto Borgo Felino
- Number 7 is just a few steps ahead, on the right

From Foresteria in Borgo Felino n. 7 to Azienda ospedaliero-universitaria di Parma (by bus)

Google Maps: Azienda ospedaliero universitaria di Parma - Viale Antonio Gramsci, 14, 43126 Parma PR

- From Borgo Felino n. 7, walk to the Municipio bus stop (about 8 minutes)
- At the stop, take bus line 5 “Via Chiavari”
- Stay on the bus for approximately 10 minutes
- Get off at the “Via Gramsci” bus stop
- The Azienda ospedaliero universitaria di Parma is located directly across from the bus stop

From Azienda ospedaliero-universitaria di Parma to Foresteria in Borgo Felino n. 7 (by bus)

- From Via Gramsci n. 14, walk to the “Ospedale Via Gramsci” bus stop
- At the stop, take bus line 12 “Panocchia Torrione”
- Stay on the bus for approximately 16 minutes
- Get off at the “Viale Basetti” bus stop
- Walk to the intersection, then turn onto Borgo Salnitrara
- Follow the route, passing through Strada Luigi Carlo Farini, until you reach the foresteria

How to reach your accomodation and the course location

From Foresteria in Borgo Felino n. 7 to Trattoria Il Cortile (by foot)

Google Maps: Trattoria il Cortile, Borgo Paglia, 3, Parma PR, Italia

- Exit the foresteria and head toward Strada Luigi Carlo Farini
- Turn right, then immediately left onto Borgo Salnitrara
- Turn right onto Borgo Girolamo Cantelli
- After about 200 meters, turn left onto Strada Ponte Caprazucca
- After about 250 meters, veer slightly right onto Piazzale Alberto Rondani
- Continue straight until you reach Borgo S. Giuseppe
- Turn right onto Vicolo Flavio Gioia, then left onto Borgo Paglia
- Trattoria Il Cortile is just a few steps ahead, on the right

From Azienda ospedaliero-universitaria di Parma to Campus Università di Parma (by bus)

- From Viale dei Mille, walk to the bus stop on Via Musini
- At the stop, take bus line 7 “Università”
- Stay on the bus for approximately 14 minutes
- After entering the Campus area, get off at the “Università Farmacia” bus stop
- On site, further directions will be provided for the guided tour

From Campus Università di Parma to Foresteria in Borgo Felino n. 7 (by bus)

- Go to the “Università Farmacia” bus stop
- At the stop, take bus line 21 “Carcere di Via Burla”
- Stay on the bus for approximately 12 minutes
- Get off at the “Via Basetti Teatro Due” bus stop
- Follow the route through Borgo Salnitrara, then continue along Strada Luigi Carlo Farini until you reach the foresteria



Discover the city of Parma

The city

Parma is a charming city located in the Emilia-Romagna region of northern Italy. Renowned worldwide for its culinary excellence, especially Parmigiano Reggiano cheese and Parma ham.

Parma also boasts a rich cultural and artistic heritage. The city is known for its elegant architecture, historic churches, and strong musical tradition, especially tied to the composer Giuseppe Verdi.

Founded by the Romans in 183 BC, Parma has long stood at the crossroads of northern Italy. Over the centuries, it grew under various rulers, from the Lombards to the powerful Farnese family, who transformed Parma into a refined cultural capital during the Renaissance. In the 19th century, it became part of the Duchy of Parma under Napoleon's second wife, Marie Louise, whose legacy still shapes the city. Parma's deep musical roots also shine through its connection to Giuseppe Verdi, born nearby, making it a pilgrimage site for opera lovers.

Parma Cathedral (Duomo di Parma): A stunning example of Romanesque architecture, the Parma Cathedral features beautiful frescoes by Correggio inside its dome.

Teatro Regio di Parma: One of Italy's most prestigious opera houses, Teatro Regio is a must-see for music lovers. It regularly hosts performances, especially during the Verdi Festival.

Palazzo della Pilotta: This historic palace complex houses several museums and the stunning Teatro Farnese, a wooden Renaissance theater.

Parco Ducale: A peaceful green space perfect for a relaxing walk, located just across the river from the city center. It once belonged to the ducal family.

Museo Glauco Lombardi: A museum dedicated to the Duchess Marie Louise and the Napoleonic era, with a rich collection of personal artifacts, paintings, and documents.

The suggestion is to take a walk, starting from Piazza del Duomo, one of the most beautiful (but least known) in the world. Not far away is the Palazzo della Pilotta, which allows you to visit two masterpieces in one go: the Teatro Farnese and the Galleria Nazionale, with works by Beato Angelico, Leonardo da Vinci, Guercino, El Greco, Tintoretto, Tiepolo, Van Dick and many others.

Correggio and Parmigianino deserve a separate mention. The former reached the pinnacle of his art by painting the dome of the Duomo and the Monastery of San Giovanni; the latter, on the other hand, found madness by seeking perfection in the frescoes of the Basilica of Santa Maria della Steccata.
